#### Notice of Hui-a-Iwi

Following extensive discussions with the Crown, on behalf of associated claimant groups and ngā uri of Raukawa, the Raukawa Trust Board/Settlement Trust is pleased to announce that the Crown has commenced direct negotiations with the Iwi regarding its historical Treaty grievances.

Consequently, we extend an invitation to all uri and claimants to become an active part of the resolution of outstanding historical claims by attending transfer of mandating hui. The main purpose of these hui will be to vote on the following resolution to transfer the current mandate of the Raukawa Trust Board and its representatives to the Raukawa Settlement Trust and its representatives:

*“This hui supports and authorises the transfer of its mandate from the Raukawa Trust Board to the Raukawa Settlement Trust to represent the Iwi of Raukawa in Treaty Negotiations with the Crown for the comprehensive settlement of all Raukawa historical Treaty Claims”*

**Iwi Endorsement Voting Process**

Uri of Raukawa who are 18 years and older are eligible to vote at the hui-a-iwi. All hui will have an attendance register that will be checked by a knowledgeable person from Raukawa. Voting will take place by a show of hands at each hui and be counted by two (2) identified scrutineers and the results recorded. A Te Puni Kokiri representative will be present at all hui to observe proceedings. All uri will be able to register prior to the hui.

These hui will provide claimants and uri an opportunity to be directly involved in the Treaty Claims process.
