Ngā Pātai Matua

1. What is the minimum te reo level a student requires?

This kura reo is for those with medium to high level Māori language ability. I.e. Those who have sufficient reo ability to function in a total immersion environment for the entire 5 days.

2. What do I need to bring?

Bring blankets, toiletries, warm clothes, umbrella (if rain is expected) writing material and pens. (Linen, mattress & pillows provided)

Dictionaries are essential for all; Williams and Ryan recommended Māori to English dictionary. Bruce Biggs recommended English to Māori dictionary.

3. Are those from iwi other than Raukawa able to attend?

One of the focus points of this kura is Raukawa / Tainui kupu, phrases & knowledge. Those from other iwi or ethnic groups are most welcome to attend.

4. I understand that children aged 4 years and under will not be catered for in the tamariki programme, but what if I have a pēpi or toddler?

You are welcome to bring pēpi that can be nursed throughout classes. Please make babysitting arrangements for toddlers.

5. Can we arrange our own accommodation off site?

Yes.

6. What if I have special meal requirements?

Please advise us of your requirements and we will try to cater accordingly.

7. When does kura reo finish?

Kura reo classes finish Thursday afternoon. This will be followed by a formal poroporoāki & hākari. A pō whakangāhau for the adults will follow the hākari so please feel welcome to stay another night.
