
Raukawa Marae


During our Treaty settlement claims, 16 Raukawa marae gave us their mandate to settle the historical claims of Raukawa with the Crown. Our many marae form the anchor stone for our people, they are our ūkaipō.


Our marae are cherished taonga that help us to strengthen and celebrate our bonds of kinship. Our takiwā is adorned with the mana, kōrero tuku iho and kōiwi of our ancestors, each marae represents a special and unique part of the collective that makes us Raukawa.
